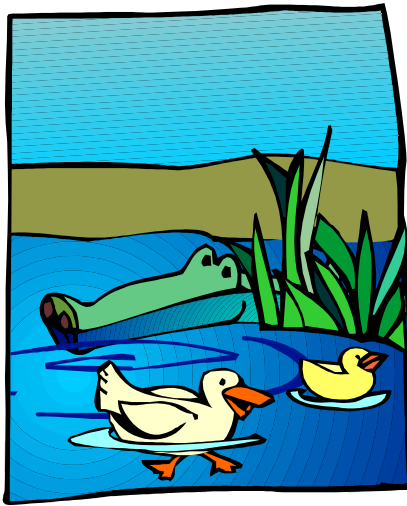

## Character Education: Cooperation



### Language Arts

The class will be reading the story All Eyes on the Pond this week. This nonfiction verse gives an in-depth look at the pond ecosystem and how each creature in this ecosystem interacts with its environment.

Grammar concepts include continued work with adjectives (adj. that compare), homographs and homophones, continued development of recognizing main ideas and details, and how to paraphrase and summarize story elements. Spelling words this week will include contractions and possessives.

### Math

We will have a brief review of Measurement on Monday and have the chapter test on Tuesday. We will then begin working in our next chapter, Fractions.

### Health

The class will be going to Mrs. Gago's class next week for health. They will be learning about health and nutrition.
